



CBSE Class 10 Syllabus 2025-26

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has released the updated syllabus for Class 10 for the academic year 2025-26. The curriculum now emphasises competency-based education, conceptual clarity, and real-world application. A major reform is the introduction of **two board exams per year**, giving students more flexibility to improve scores.

Key Updates for 2025-26

- Two board exams annually for flexibility.
- Greater weightage for application-based and competency-based questions.
- Integration of project-based learning in core subjects.

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- Balanced evaluation: theory + internal assessment + practicals (where applicable).
